# EAST DEVON DISTRICT COUNCIL Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Council held at Knowle, Sidmouth, on Wednesday, 18 May 2016

Attendance list at the end of document.

The meeting started at 6.30 pm and ended at 7.30 pm

#### \*1 Election of Chairman

Councillor Stuart Hughes (Chairman) invited nominations for the office of Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year.

Councillor Tom Wright proposed and Councillor Dean Barrow seconded Councillor Stuart Hughes being elected Chairman of the Council for a second year.

In proposing, Councillor Wright said that Councillor Hughes was an exemplary Chairman and ambassador for the Council. In seconding, Councillor Barrow echoed the comments of the proposer.

There were no other nominations.

#### **RESOLVED**

that Councillor Stuart Hughes be elected Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year.

Following the election, Councillor Hughes read, and signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office. He then spoke in response to his election. He thanked his proposer and seconder and the other Members for putting their trust in him to continue to fly the flag for the Council at the various events he attended, which he did with pride. He advised that the Council was held in very high regard by other dignitaries in the area and paid thanks to the Chief Executive, and those officers who helped and supported him in fulfilling his role as Chairman.

## \*2 Appointment of Vice Chairman

The Chairman invited nominations for the appointment of Vice Chairman of the Council for the ensuing Civic Year.

Councillor Mike Howe proposed and Councillor Jill Elson seconded Councillor Helen Parr being appointed Vice-Chairman of the Council for a second year.

In proposing, Councillor Howe praised Councillor Parr for her work on behalf of the Council which she approached in a quiet, commendable and considered way.

In seconding, Councillor Elson said that Councillor Parr was a very well respected and knowledgeable Councillor.

There were no further nominations.

#### **RESOLVED**

that Councillor Helen Parr be appointed Vice-Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year.

Following the appointment, Councillor Parr, read, and signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office. She then spoke in response to her appointment, thanking her proposer and seconder and other Members for putting their confidence in her. She said that she had very much enjoyed supporting the Chairman and that it would be a pleasure to continue to represent to the Council in the role of Vice-Chairman, which she would do so to the best of her ability.

#### \*3 Public Speaking

The Chairman welcomed Councillors, Honorary Aldermen and members of the public. There were no questions.

### \*4 Urgent item

The Chairman advised of the resignation from the District Council of David Foster due to family and work commitments.

He also announced, with sadness, that Alison Greenhalgh had passed away at the weekend. He said that Alison has been elected to the District Council in 2015 and represented Exmouth Littleham Ward. She had served on a number of Committees – Development Management Committee, Scrutiny Committee, and Licensing and Enforcement Committee – and was also Member Champion for Tourism. He advised that in her short time on the Council Alison had gained a lot of respect from both her fellow Councillors and Officers and would be greatly missed by many. He offered sympathy and best wishes to her family and friends at this very sad time.

The Chairman invited Councillor Jill Elson to address the Council. Councillor Elson spoke of Alison's commitment to her role as both an Exmouth Town and District Councillor. Alison was well-respected and her loss would be felt deeply by many, but particularly her Exmouth colleagues. Her thoughts went to her family and friends.

The Chairman invited Members to stand in silence as a mark of respect.

#### \*5 Minutes

The minutes of the meeting of the Council held on 20 April 2016 were confirmed and signed as a true record.

#### \*6 Declarations of interest

There were none.

#### \*7 Chairman's announcements

a) Long Service awards

The Chairman advised that from now on, Long Service awards would be presented to staff at the annual meeting of the Council. He welcomed the opportunity to present service awards to long-serving staff; it was a chance for the Council to thank them for their valued contribution. He highlighted the achievements of Amy Gilbert, Property and Asset Manager, Housing, who had worked for EDDC for 10 years. Amy was then awarded with a certificate by the Vice Chairman.

Councillor Douglas Hull took the opportunity to announce that that Councillor Jill Elson had been a member of the Council for 35years and thanked her for all her hard work on behalf of the Council.

#### b) Invitation

The Chairman invited Councillors, Honorary Aldermen and guests to a buffet in the Members' Area following the close of the meeting. He also extended the invitation to Amy Gilbert and her guests.

#### \*8 Leader of the Council

Councillor Philip Skinner proposed Councillor Paul Diviani as Leader of the Council for the ensuing year. This proposal was seconded by Councillor Maria Hale.

In proposing, Councillor Skinner offered his full support to Councillor Diviani who continued to lead the Council in an exceptional manner and with dignity.

In seconding, Councillor Maria Hale echoed the comments of the proposer.

In accepting his appointment, Councillor Diviani thanked his proposer and seconder and spoke of the need to continue to work hard for the ongoing success of the Council.

He said that he was deeply saddened by the untimely death of Alison Greenhalgh. He advised that her impact in her one year as a District Councillor had been considerable and that they all, but especially her Exmouth colleagues, would miss her considered insights and well-reasoned debates. He added his condolences to those already expressed and that his thoughts were with her family.

During his speech the Leader referred to:

- ➤ The successful opening of the Jurassic Coast visitor centre, which even after a few short weeks was absolutely "flying". It was a key part of the resurgence in Seaton which, when combined with the Axe Valley wetlands, beach area and Seaton Tramway made it a true destination town. He advised that the economic spin-off in to the town itself could not be underestimated.
- ➤ The new EDDC waste and recycling service contract which would be rolled out in the next financial year and would include the collection of recyclable cardboard and mixed plastics.
- Communications In 2015 there were 570,000 visitors to the Council's website, which was available 24/7 for business transactions on-line.

He advised that 2016/17 would see the Council face new challenges in service delivery. New projects would be started and existing one completed, not least in Exmouth, Sidmouth and Axminster which would deliver new jobs and improved economic prosperity. He stated that East Devon truly was a good place to live, work and enjoy.

## \*9 Appointment of Deputy Leader

The Leader confirmed his appointment of Councillor Andrew Moulding as Deputy Leader of the Council. Councillor Diviani said that his Deputy was a natural choice and that he continued to be highly supportive in his role.

In response, Councillor Moulding thanked the Leader and advised that he relished the challenge of the role.

#### \*10 Cabinet Members and Portfolio Holders

The Leader proposed no changes to the titles of Portfolio Holders and that the Cabinet would again include two Members who were not members of the ruling party as Cabinet Members without Portfolio.

\*Tim Swarbrick (non-voting independent representative) was originally appointed in 2012 for a 4-year term. Council approved a second 4-year term to retain Mr Swarbrick's experience and knowledge.

#### Non-voting Parish/Town Council representatives:

Councillors Jessica Bailey (Ottery St Mary Town Council and Frances Newth (Sidmouth Town Council).

**Non-voting Independent persons –** Alison Willan and John Walpole – not members of the Standards Committee but are consulted by the Monitoring Officer on Code of Conduct Complaints. Their original appointment in 2012 was for a term of 4 years. Council approved a second 4-year term so that their experience and knowledge could continue to be used for the benefit of the Council and support its governance arrangements.

#### \*13 Report of the Chief Executive

#### b) Amendments to the Council's Constitution

The main proposed amendments in the Constitution included:

- The creation of a Strategic Planning Committee remit, membership and terms of reference
- Amendments to the delegations to Portfolio Holders
- > Amendments to Officer delegations
- Public speaking arrangements Development Management Committee and Strategic Planning Committee
- Scrutiny practices
- Asset Management Forum

The report also included a table of minor/consequential amendments.

The Leader of the Independent Group proposed that this item be deferred for the Overview Committee to consider. The Chief Executive advised that this was inappropriate as the Scheme of Delegations had to be adopted at his meeting. Either the Chief Executive or the Monitoring Officer would liaise with the Leader of the Independent Group after the meeting to understand his concerns and assess the most appropriate means of dealing with such concerns.

#### c) Annual reports:

#### **Overview Committee**

Councillor Peter Bowden, Chairman of the Overview Committee presented the annual report, commenting that nothing could be achieved without the hard work of the Committee and paid particular thanks to the Vice-Chairman of the Committee, Councillor Graham Godbeer.

#### **Scrutiny Committee**

Councillor Roger Giles, Chairman of the Scrutiny Committee presented the Committee's annual report. He thanked the Committee and the officers for their hard work and drew attention to the Committee's role as a critical friend.

#### **Housing Review Board**

Councillor Pauline Stott, Chairman of the Housing Review Board presented the Board's annual report. She praised the work of the Board and the Housing Team.

Councillor Douglas Hull praised the Chairman of the Board, its Members, the Housing Team, and the Portfolio Holder – Sustainable Homes and Communities for their work supporting the Council's tenants. He encouraged Members to read the Board's annual report if they had not already done so.

The Leader advised that he had recently attended a conference in London with the Chief Executive where EDDC was seen as the market leader in housing. He thanked all those who had made it possible.

#### d) Member Champions/Lead Councillors

Councillor Mark Williamson, Member Champion for Neighbourhood Plans spoke on behalf of the Council's Member Champions/Lead Councillors and highlighted the value of their work to the Council. He urged Members to read the report if they had not already done so in order to understand the breadth and value of the work undertaken.
