- 1. Ensure we are doing all we can to work with our partners to more visibly promote take up of Schemes such as Kickstart, and are actively signposting local businesses to two new Devon programmes, 'SMART SKILLS' and 'Skills Support for the Workforce', in order to support those at risk of financial difficulties by offering solutions to local employers, and including those aged 16 24 on Universal Credit, to gain employment for a minimum of 6 months
- Request an urgent report to a forthcoming Cabinet meeting setting out potential options for directing additional resources into the Anti-Poverty Strategy to support the District in helping the most vulnerable residents this winter, in the light of unexpected rising living costs
