

4.6.2 Exploring Natural Seaton: beyond the Centre, into the outdoors

Moving from the underwater landscape, the journey through the remainder of the outside space is a journey which echoes the landscape of Natural Seaton. Visitors go on a pathway from open sea to water source. A winding, central path echoes the twists of the River Axe as it moves through the landscape. On either side of the path are smaller paths or tributaries lead to activity spaces which mirror local natural landscape features: sea cliffs, beaches of sand and pebbles, saltmarsh, reed beds, and on through rolling farmland (see illustration below).



The Centre's outside space will take visitors on a journey from sea to source, echoing the landscapes features of Natural Seaton around them.
