(1) *Previous Minutes (CGP 61);*

The minutes of the previous CGP meeting held on the 22 July 2021 were recommended for approval.

(2) *Bid applications for approval (CPG Min 65 – 67);*

the sum of £3,000 for Branscombe Pavilion from the Community Buildings Fund, subject to planning permission being in place.

the sum of £3,364 towards the Lypstone Village Hall project from the Community Buildings Fund

the sum of £2,590 be made towards the project for Northleigh Village Hall from the Community Buildings Fund

(3) *Bid application to be deferred (CPG Min 68);*

the application for Offwell Sports and Social Club from the Community Buildings Fund, be deferred, in order for the applicant to resubmit the application once the new 50 year lease was in place, and the application to the parish council for funding had reached a decision

(4) *Community Buildings Fund (Cabinet Min 59);*

that the Community Buildings Fund eligibility criteria be extended to include:

a. Community buildings within town council areas, but outside of the town itself and in a separate village;

b. all community-owned pubs.
