The Strategic Lead Housing, Health & Environment outlined the input into the draft Devon Carbon Plan that had been proposed through the Devon Citizens Assembly process. All signatories to the Devon Climate Emergency Declaration had been invited to consider and comment on the resolutions put forward by the Citizens or more correctly the Devon Climate Assembly prior to a further round of public consultation. He

suggested that the council welcomed the resolutions presented by the Climate Assembly and to work collectively with the Devon Climate Change Partnership, to incorporate the resolutions into the revised and updated version of the Devon Carbon Plan. Cabinet was invited to comment on the actions proposed in the annex to the report.
