Viewable copies of CCTV recordings will be provided on request to the Police and local authority officers as soon as is reasonably practicable and in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 or a staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises are open. All instances of crime and disorder will be reported to the Police as soon as reasonably practicable.
