Report:

This report follows on from an Audit and Governance members skills assessment carried out by SWAP earlier in the year. This was with the previous Committee membership but is considered still relevant and will be followed up with a further survey once training has been provided to ensure continuous improvements.

The work of the Committee is technical, and it was positive to note from the survey that there was a good coverage of abilities overall. Some gaps were identified, most significantly in respect of:

- Governance
- Counter-Fraud
- Treasury Management.
