Good afternoon,

I would like to point out one or two things about taxi ranks in Seaton.

Firstly there are only 4 in total, 1 in Queen street just recently refurbished, 1 in Fore street by Central stores that you can no longer see that it is a taxi rank (so continually used by the public) and the 2 bays in Marine Place.

I don't mind the movement of the rank but cutting it to 1 bay leaves just 3 in total for us all. The council traffic warden is quite happy to move us on or fine us for parking in normal bays when our bay is full. We only use the taxi bay to pick up trade, have a quick bite to eat or to use the toilet. If Seaton Town council were to consider putting a couple of taxi bays into the coach park in the Underfleet that would assist us all. There is more than enough room here and there is also access to the main town drop off / collection points such as Tesco, Jurassic centre and Tramway.
