Supporting the panel will be the Service Lead – Place, Assets and Commercialisation and Project Manager – Place & Prosperity. The panel will carry out the evaluation of the bids received following the marketing exercise with a view to making a recommendation to Cabinet in relation to the preferred bidder/operator. If no suitable external bidder is identified, the project will be referred back to Cabinet to review the entire phase 3 plan, with full public engagement. If the Council is minded to invest in a hotel or other business on the site the decision will be reviewed by SWAP to advise on risk.
